

Volunteer Job Description

Volunteer Position Title: Clinical Provider

<u>Purpose/objective:</u> Provide ongoing comprehensive internal medicine and gynecological care for uninsured patients aged 18 and up, almost all with chronic diseases.

<u>Location</u>: Providers have two options to volunteer. 1) Open Door Clinic within UMWC 1390 Capital Blvd. 2) Remote Telehealth medical appointments (once fully oriented)

Key responsibilities:

- Review chart materials via EMR for patients prior to visit (including any recent labs, radiological studies, hospital or ED visits or consults) & complete chart notes after visits.
- 2) Interview patient regarding new complaints as well as follow up on chronic conditions.
- 3) Familiarity with use of foreign language interpreter is recommended.
- 4) Review medication compliance and need for refills. Examine any on-site patients.
- 5) Recommend to patient any treatment or diagnostic studies pertinent to acute or chronic complaints. Lab and Radiological work-up prior to referral highly recommended.
- 6) Order medications, tests or laboratory studies pertinent to the clinical scenario.
- 7) Consult with Open Door Clinic staff and volunteer instruction guides regarding any procedural questions.

Qualifications: Unrestricted Active NC License. Accepting MD, DO, PA or NP.

Malpractice Insurance (if you do not have access to malpractice insurance, we can provide it for you under certain terms).

<u>Time commitment:</u> We kindly ask that you commit to at least two *3-3.5 hr* shifts per month, for at least a year.

<u>Schedule</u>: Open Door Clinic is open Monday through Thursday 9 AM-5 PM and some Tues/Weds evening shifts 4:30-7:30 PM may be available as staffing permits. Individual shifts may be requested through an online volunteer sign-up module.

<u>Training/support provided:</u>

- 1. Interview with Executive Director & meeting with Medical Director
- 2. Shadow Clinic staff for 2-3 shifts or until clinician & mentor feel comfortable
- 3. Telemedicine training can also be done on-site until competency attained.

Benefits: Improving healthcare access for medically underserved population of Wake County.
